John and his two oldest sons obtained land grants in Peterborough County (Otonabee Township), but John died about 1828. At least one of John's sons remained in Durham County - the remainder of the family had moved to Otonabee Township by 1830. Ellen								

	<p>remarried and John's oldest son seems to have cared for his younger siblings for several years.
